Additional Considerations

Rates evaluated each fiscal year and subject to change. For purposes related to budgeting multi-year projects, an annual 5% increase in user rates should be anticipated. Pre-payments are not allowed under any circumstances. All payments must be for services rendered. Services purchased with sponsored funds must be directly allocable to the funding project. Direct materials cost estimates available upon request. Some resources have a daily maximum reservation. Training required for self-service use. Multifunction space technology reservation costs are calculated using a variety of factors. A typical multifunction space technology reservation for non-commercial use is \$50.00.
